- How do you think helping to meet those needs might help you share the message of Jesus with the people in your life?
- Read James 1:22-27. How does this passage connect to our conversation today? What idea or phrase stands out to you personally, and why?
- In your school, community, or family, what's one way you're going to be helpful . . .
 - With your words?
 - With your actions?
 - With your relationships?
- Who is someone you'd like to talk with about Jesus? Why do you want to talk with them? What's your next step?
